The school runs courses throughout the year with several extremely talented and experienced artists/teachers including Fiona McKinnon and Heather Rankin, catering for all levels of experience from beginners through to advanced.

JENNY PHILLIPS FLS

Jenny Phillips is arguably Australia's most influential botanical art teacher.

She is a Gold Medalist from The Australian National Print Awards 1998, The Royal Horticultural Society London 1993, The Celia Rosser Award 2008, and has focused her drawing, watercolour skills, and love of gardening on botanical art since 1971. In doing so, she has developed her skill and knowledge to a remarkable level.

Jenny is represented in many public and private collections around the world, most recently painting 6 botanic artworks for HRH Prince of Wales. Major exhibitions include London and New York. Since 1996 she has taught Master Classes in major Australian cities, as well as in London, New York, Venice, Paris, Leiden, Cape Town, Johannesburg, Tokyo, Denver, Charleston, Los Angeles, and San Francisco.

Jenny's ability to capture the essence, beauty and life of a plant, without compromising on botanical details, makes her work extremely collectible.
